

## HOW LONG CAN A STUDENT'S ENTHUSIASM FOR LEARNING LAST?




It will last for as long as their parents and teachers believe in them and praise them for their effortsactively building their confidence, competence and self-esteem daily!

So how long will their enthusiasm for learning last under these motivational conditions?....As long as their parents and teachers continue to believe in them! So the prognosis is...forever!

The difference between an enthusiastic learner and one who is disaffected is passion! The level of interest, love and care that each child applies to the learning process is directly proportionate to the level of passion which the child has for their learning. The level of passion and interest displayed by the child will directly influence their learning input and ultimate outcomes. While many children are self-motivated, others are in need of constant reassurance and encouragement. Some may need a more strict regime involving consistent guidance and strong levels of supervision daily- but this needs to be balanced with praise for their efforts. If a child is enthusiastic they will have a much more positive approach to their learning. But...we must all remember parents that attitude and approach are learnt behaviours. Is our enthusiasm evident to our children? If not... we need to raise our game and by extension help them to raise theirs!
